

## 1986 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## VINTAGE NOTES, WINEMAKER CATHY CORISON

Warm, early spring temperatures and an extended mild 1986 VINTAGE: summer season resulted in even ripening and excellent fruit quality. The resulting Cabernet displays a brilliant ruby color with forward aromas of ripe fruit, cracked pepper, cedar and flower petals.

AROMAS: Ripe plums, cassis and tobacco leaf; layers of smoky cedar, violets, rose and mint.

FLAVORS: Layered plummy fruit with supple mouth feel and soft tannins; cassis and cranberry with a touch of mint and anise. Lively finish with good length.
