

## 1988 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## VINTAGE NOTES, WINEMAKER PHILLIP CORALLO-TITUS

1988 VINTAGE: Moderate late-winter temperatures encouraged early warming of the soils and accelerated the spring bud break. temperate weather throughout the late spring and summer, combined with early budding of the vines to create an early harvest. Our dry-farmed Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards were harvested during late August and early September.

AROMAS: Youthful, bright aromas of blackberry, strawberry, currant and plum are accented by notes of cedar, coffee, anise and mint.

FLAVORS: Spicy oak and vanilla wraps around ripe berry and black cherry fruit and traces of fresh herbs, coffee and tobacco. Young, supple tannins balance fresh acidity and medium-bodied fruit flavors in a wine that is delicious paired with lamb, barbecued meats and rich pasta dishes. Our estate-grown Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is smooth and ready to drink now, yet will continue to improve over the next several years.
